

Europe pays with Payment2Go

A new independence for electronic banking! BELLIN introduces new payment solution "Payment2Go"

BELLIN, a software provider based in Ettenheim/Germany, has launched a new payment system next to its treasury platform tm5. This Web-based payment solution is called Payment2Go (P2G).

"This system covers local payments in many European countries and allows enterprises to organize their own multi-bank payment transactions. Companies cooperating with multiple banks can use P2G as a single payment portal for all their banks and accounts. Payment2Go enables small and medium-sized businesses to gain an unprecedented independence, since banks usually push the adoption of their own solutions," explains CEO Martin Bellin.

The second reason for this new product is the ongoing change in the European market for payment systems.

„A specialized product allows for a better reaction to changing requirements“, says Bellin.

The multi-bank capability saves companies the trouble of having to use several banking portals side by side. P2G is offered as a so-called SaaS (Software as a Service) solution. This means that the application is completely provided and run by BELLIN. The clients save on hardware acquisition and operation. Martin Bellin states: "This reduces operation complexity, disburdens local IT departments and offers a cost-efficient payments option." Enterprises already using tm5 can also employ Payment2Go, both as a supplement and as a backup.
